<b>Pairs Championship (4 woods)</b>	21 ends
<b>Points (4 woods)</b>	Preliminary rounds – 81 points Semi-final and final – 101 points
<b>Fixed Jack (4 woods)</b>	Played to 101 points
<b>Veterans Pairs (2 woods)</b>	10 ends. Final 21 ends
<b>2 Wood Championship</b>	21 ends (each round)
<b>Novices – Joan Neville Salver (4 woods)</b>	21 shots
<b>Mixed Pairs</b>	3 timed rounds of 1 hour with final played to 21 ends

In all these Competitions dead ends to be replayed and tied ends are carried down **NOT** replayed

**Restrictions on competition entry are applicable in 2 cases:**

1. Joan Neville Salver is only open to members who have never won any competitions at the Club (not including the Friendship Cup)
2. As the word "Veterans" implies, only members age 65 and over may participate

**Basic Rules :**

1. The first name(s) in the draw shall be the challenger(s) and the challenger(s) shall be responsible for arranging the fixture.
2. Two dates/times should be offered to an opponent
3. The challenger(s) must provide a marker where necessary who must be an experienced bowler. (No Spouses or Partners)
4. **All cards must be signed and placed in the box provided**
5. **All rounds must be played by the specified dates.** Failure to do this is unfair to fellow bowlers, especially those winning through to later rounds. A knock on effect is created and time may become tighter for others than would have been the case.
