### IMPORTANT COMPETITION INFORMATION – PLEASE READ

<b>Club Championship</b> (4 woods)	Play to <b>21</b> shots
<b>Ladies Points</b> (4 woods)	Preliminary rounds – play to <b>81</b> points Semi-final and final rounds – play to <b>101</b> points
<b>Fixed Jack</b> (4 woods)	Play to <b>101</b> points
<b>Joan Neville Salver</b> (4 woods)	Play to <b>21</b> shots
<b>Ladies 2 Wood Singles*</b>	Preliminary play <b>10</b> ends, then Final <b>21</b> ends
<b>Ladies 2 Wood Pairs*</b>	Preliminary play 3 x <b>10</b> ends then Final <b>21</b> ends
<b>Triples*</b>	Play <b>18</b> ends- preliminary & final rounds
<b>Ladies Australian Pairs*</b> (4 woods)	Play <b>18</b> ends -preliminary & final rounds
<b>Mixed Pairs*</b>	Preliminary - <b>3</b> x rounds of <b>1</b> hour Final – play to <b>21</b> ends
<b>ALL COMPETITIONS: Dead ends</b> – to be replayed. <b>Tied ends</b> – carried down and <b>NOT</b> replayed.	

#### Restrictions on entries that are applicable:

1. The Joan Neville Salver, which is only open to Members who have never won any other competition at the Club, with the exception of the Friendship Cup
2. All entrants to be available to play final rounds on a **designated day**, Saturday, Sunday or Monday, of the **August Bank Holiday weekend**. If a competitor becomes aware that they will be unable to play on a Finals Day – please advise the Competition Secretary – Susie Sealy, mobile 0781 396 5183, as soon as possible

#### Basic Rules for Playing:

1. Competitions to be arranged for the **Early Rounds days**, or a minimum of **two dates/times** to be offered to **Opponent (s)** or days **set\* in the Fixture List**
2. The **first** name(s) in the draw shall be the **Challenger(s)** and the **Challenger(s)** shall be responsible for arranging the fixture
3. The **Challenger(s)** must provide **an approved marker, or a suitably experienced bowler**, (no spouses or partners) where necessary - **see list in folder**
4. **All cards must be signed and placed in the box provided after the game is completed**
5. **All rounds must be played by or on the specified dates/days.** Failure to do this is unfair to fellow bowlers, especially those who are through to the later rounds  
A knock-on effect is created and time to play may become tighter for others, than would have been the case
